Scenic Zodiac Tour Fiordland National Park*

Fiordland National Park is your gateway to the Te Wahipounamu UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore the region’s deeply incised fjords by way of Seabourn Quest’s very own fleet of zodiacs. You’ll discover areas of the fjords that most ships can’t access. Fiordland’s snow-covered peaks soar 5,000 feet and its U-shaped valleys, sculpted by glaciers reach for the water’s edge. From sea level, these geological features are dramatic and enthralling.

Trinity Island by Zodiac*

The re-discovered mangrove system around Trinity Island invites you to explore by zodiac with the Ventures team. As you cruise the waterways, winding through a 115-square-mile maze of mangroves, expect to see rich, diverse wildlife and stunning scenery. This is the saltwater crocodile’s natural habitat — you may have a chance to spot them basking on the muddy banks. Trinity Inlet is home to some of the rarest birds in Australia, offering excellent sighting opportunities for avid bird watchers.

Hike & Kayak the Marlborough Sounds*

Join the Ventures team for a guided hike on one of the many walking trails that the Picton area has to offer. Experience spectacular natural surroundings keeping an eye and ear out for the local birdlife — fantails, kereru (enormous wood pigeons), silvereyes, grey warblers, bellbirds and kingfisher in this predator-free sanctuary. After the hike, hop into a kayak for a scenic paddle enjoying the tranquil waters of Queen Charlotte Sound.

Ultimate Fiji Island Paradise by Zodiac*

Be among a handful of privileged Seabourn guests, who through the Ventures by Seabourn program get to explore the southern reaches of the Dravuni archipelago. A scenic zodiac transfer will bring you to the islands of Yabu and Buliya, depending on conditions, we will choose one of these remote islands as the day’s destination. Enjoy guided snorkeling tours with our resident marine biologist, in search of dolphins, sea turtles, corals and a colorful array of exotic fish. Assistance will be offered by the team for first time snorkelers.

Colo-i-Suva Forest Reserve*

Located just outside the capital city of Suva on Viti Levu, the Colo-i-Suva Forest Reserve is home to a wide variety of plant and animal life and a great area for bird-watching. Join the Ventures team and a local guide as you make your way through the trails, passing crystal clear rivers and small waterfalls, enjoy scenic lookouts and keep an eye out for some of the many endemic bird species such as the Fiji Goshawk, Golden Dove, Barking Imperial Pigeon, Collared Lory, Masked Shining Parrot. The park is set in peaceful surroundings amidst a spectacular rainforest that will sooth your soul as you immerse yourself in nature’s beauty.

Heavenly Turtle Bay and Brush Island by Zodiac*

Join your Ventures Team for a zodiac snorkel safari heading to Turtle Bay, you’ll quickly discover why it’s been given that name: loggerhead and green turtles love this popular feeding spot. If the turtles are feeling really friendly, you might join them for a swim! Back in the zodiacs as we head for the uninhabited Brush Island where a sparkling beach awaits you. Don your snorkel gear once more, stroll the white-sand beach or simply relax before returning to the ship.

Savala Island Paradise by Kayak*

Magnificent Savala beach awaits you and the Ventures team. Set off by Zodiac and join our marine biologist for a snorkel adventure exploring the underwater world encompassing a large maritime area. Colorful crinoids, nudibranchs, giant clams, turtles, corals of numerous shapes and sizes, and a multitude of reef and pelagic fish, sharks, and rays inhabit the reefs — all within easy swimming distance of the beach. Enjoy a leisurely swim taking in the tropical surroundings or take a relaxing stroll along the beach.

Zodiac & Guided Ulva Island Hike

A scenic zodiac ride from Golden Bay to Ulva Island rewards you with time on this whole-island bird sanctuary. With the Ventures team, you’ll see rare and endangered bird and plant species that thrive here. As you hike, watch for the saddleback, precocious South Island robin, the colorful Tui, and the vocal Bellbird. You may be lucky enough to spot an elusive kaka (native parrot) or some cheeky Wekas — bush hens that are quite happy to relieve you of any shiny or tasty belongings you might have along.
