**Extend your exploration of the Mediterranean with our Shore Experiences by Seabourn including the below sampling of our optional shore excursions.**

**CÁDIZ (SEVILLE) – THE VERY BEST OF SEVILLE: A UNESCO PARTNER TOUR**

Travel across Andalusia to visit some of Spain's distinctive historical heritage. Its Gothic cathedral incorporates the majestic Giralda Almohad minaret as a belltower. The Alcázar Palace dates from the Reconquest, but reveals Spain's enduring taste for Moorish influences, as does the resplendent Plaza de España dating from 1928.

**DUBROVNIK – DUBROVNIK CABLE CAR RIDE & A STROLL THROUGH OLD TOWN: A UNESCO PARTNER TOUR**

Enjoy aerial views of the enchanting Pearl of the Adriatic from the top of Srđ Hill, then descend and stroll the Old Town's Stradun main street to the Rector's Palace, cathedral, Sponza Palace, the Church of Saint Blaise and Onofriou's Fountain. In the Rupe Granary Museum, an archaeologist provides insights into Dubrovnik's history and culture since the 16th century.

**KÉRKIRA, NISOS KÉRKIRA (CORFU) – CORFU OLD FORTRESS & GOURMET SNACK: A UNESCO PARTNER TOUR**

Take a guided tour of one of Europe's most impressive fortifications. Byzantines built a tower on the Acropolis when Corcyra was founded. Venetians expanded it between the 15th and 18th centuries, adding a moat, walls and the Doric-style Church of St. George. Afterward, enjoy a Corfiot culinary treat at the famous Corfu Sailing Club.

**KOS, NISOS KOS – ASKLEPION – THE HOME OF MEDICINE: A MINDFUL LIVING TOUR**

Asklepion was a temple to the god of health on Kos, where Hippocrates developed early healing principles. See the Roman Odeon Theater and the Greco-Roman Nymphaeum and Xysto ruins. Then harvest ripe olives, press your own oil, and visit an ancient plane tree some believe was where Hippocrates taught.

**LA JOLIETTE (MARSEILLE) – CHÂTEAUNEUF & AVIGNON: A UNESCO PARTNER TOUR**

Travel overland to Avignon, where a succession of nine Catholic popes reigned in the 14th century. Their tenure brought acclaim to the Châteauneuf-du-Pape wines made nearby. Enjoy exclusive guided access to the Saint Martial Chapel in the Popes' Palace, taste the region's wines and enjoy a luncheon at a Rhône River auberge.

**PORTOVENERE (CINQUE TERRE) – VILLAGES OF CINQUE TERRE: A UNESCO PARTNER TOUR**

Clinging to the Ligurian coastal cliffs, the 'Five Lands' are one of Italy's most iconic landscapes. Arrive by boat at pretty, pastel-tinted Vernazza, to stroll its charming, 1st-century streets. Then sail on to beach-front Monterosso, for a guided tour and a sample of local wine and focaccia.

**TANGIER – DISCOVER TANGIER: KASBAH, MUSEUM & MARKET**

Walk through Tangier, a fascinating mix of Moroccan, Spanish and French cultures. The Kasbah sprawls atop the medina, the city's oldest quarter. Its museum offers insights into its history. Below that is the picturesque Grand Socco market. The American Legation arrived here in 1821 — Morocco was one of the first nations to recognize the newly independent republic.

**VALLETTA – EXTRAORDINARY HAL SAFLIENI HYPOGEUM: A UNESCO PARTNER TOUR**

Visit two exceptional archaeological sites: The Hypogeum of Hal Saflieni is a Bronze Age underground temple and necropolis dating from 3600 BC. Even older are the megalithic Hagar Qim Temples predating Egypt's pyramids. In Valletta's National Museum of Archeology, see artifacts from these and other prehistoric Maltese sites, before enjoying a local lunch.
