

NORTHERN EUROPE FEATURED PORTS

OSLO, NORWAY

Norway's largest city is a masterpiece of modern architecture, classic culture, cutting-edge food and fashion, Viking history, and all kinds of art. Museums, parks, and the stunning Opera House are must-sees while here.

GOTHENBURG, SWEDEN

This picturesque port town is impressive for its natural beauty and charm. The many gorgeous botanical gardens, flower beds and parks are dazzling in color and wildlife, with an equally vibrant café, boutique and theatre scene.

COPENHAGEN, DENMARK

From the hearty waterfront cheer of Nyhavn to the serenity of Rosenborg and Amalienborg castles, Copenhagen is a charmer. Shop 'til you drop on the Strøget walking street, and visit fanciful Tivoli amusement park.

WISMAR, GERMANY

As the largest market square in Germany and home to one of the finest preserved examples of German Brick Gothic architecture, this UNESCO World Heritage Site has been an important Baltic seaport from the 1300s to today.

HAMBURG, GERMANY

Free spirited, artsy and diverse Hamburg is an eclectic city where you can relax in lovely parks one minute, browse an outdoor market the next, take in live theatre or comedy, or stroll red-brick canals all in the same day.

ZEEBRUGGE (BRUSSELS), BELGIUM

This is our portal to the fairytale charms of Bruges. Laced by canals and bristling with confectionary gothic steeples, its historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Further afield is the capital of Brussels, headquarters of the European Union.

DOUGLAS, ISLE OF MAN, UNITED KINGDOM

A unique self-governing island in the Irish Sea, the Isle of Man is a melting pot of character with stunning natural landscapes, unspoiled beaches, nature reserves, historic churches, diverse museums, and nautical exhibits.

BELFAST, NORTHERN IRELAND, UNITED KINGDOM

Belfast's center is an attractive place with street musicians and a revitalized river front. Visit Titanic Belfast, the star-shaped repository of all things RMS *Titanic*.

ROTHESAY, ISLE OF BUTE, SCOTLAND, UNITED KINGDOM

Imagine the quintessential medieval village. It likely looks like Rothesay. The castle with drawbridge and moat, a 6th-century monastery on a hill, walled gardens, and elegant estate homes all more than live up to the fantasy.

NEWHAVEN (EDINBURGH), SCOTLAND, UNITED KINGDOM

Just north of the Edinburgh city center, this coastal suburb is a quaint gateway to Edinburgh Castle, Holyrood Palace, the Royal Mile, Scottish National Gallery, a vibrant arts and cultural scene, year-round festivals, and much more.

REYKJAVÍK, ICELAND

Reykjavík, Iceland's capital, is the northern-most national capital in the world. Its name translates as 'smoky bay', referencing the geothermal nature of the surrounding area.









NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE, ENGLAND, UNITED KINGDOM

Newcastle is a tasteful mix of new and old. Gorgeous newer bridges and the spherical Sage Gateshead Concert Hall stand alongside the traditional Theatre Royal, the Castle Keep, cathedrals, and the serene Jesmond Dene Park.

BORDEAUX, FRANCE

See one of France's most beloved wine regions by sailing up the Garonne river. Stately architecture and a charming promenade line the riverfront, inviting you to explore picturesque parks, cafés, cultural sites, and taste world-class vintages.

SVOLVÆR (LOFOTEN), NORWAY

Fishermen flock here in winter, and artists adore their rugged peaks, shining seas, and extraordinary light. Cruise by Zodiac® to explore this archipelago from hidden channels only accessible to small craft. Or join our kayak guide to paddle the waterways near Svolvær – the capital.

TROMSØ, NORWAY

Located 200 miles north of the Arctic Circle, Tromsø basks in the midnight sun during summer months. Notable landmarks include the distinctive Arctic Cathedral, the Tromsø University Museum, and the unique Polar Museum.

ROUEN (PARIS), FRANCE

Among the most popular cities of outer Paris, Rouen, the "City of a Hundred Spires," is home to the Cathedrale Notre-Dame, the Gros-Horloge Renaissance clock, the Place du Vieux Marche, and enduring medieval ambience.





FEATURED PORTS

PALMA DE MALLORCA, SPAIN

Spain's sunny Mediterranean outpost is a pleasant spot boasting a shady plaza near the Gothic Cathedral. Perhaps journey to the enchanting village of Valldemossa, but leave time to shop for false (but lovely) Majorica pearls and handmade lace.

LIMASSOL, CYPRUS

Along with ten miles of meandering shoreline, Limassol features mountain villages, castles and basilicas, ancient archaeological sites dating back to 7,000 BC, vineyards, an upscale marina town with friendly restaurants and chic fashion and jewelry boutiques.

AMALFI, ITALY

One of the two main towns on the famed Amalfi drive, Amalfi is known for its stunning beaches, majestic Duomo di Sant'Andrea cathedral, colorful Majolica tiles, the Chiostro del Paradiso cloister gardens and The Museo della Carta where you can make paper using the traditional medieval methods.


GOLFO ARANCI, SARDINIA, ITALY

The Sardinian coastline is serrated by deep-cut coves of sparkling sea, surrounded by rocky prominences and edged in lovely strands of beach. The Aga Khan fell in love with the place, and dubbed it the Costa Smeralda, creating a magnet for the global glitterati, who adore its silvery white sands.

ST. TROPEZ, FRANCE

The modern glamour never really deserts this town famous for Bardot and a film festival, but the venerable village perché of Grimaud in the nearby Maures Massif has an 11th-century Grimaud Castle with links to Monaco's ruling Grimaldis.







MÁLAGA (GRANADA), SPAIN

The birthplace of Pablo Picasso, Málaga wine, and a style of flamenco, Málaga is an incredibly interesting glimpse at life in southern Spain through the ages. First settled by the Phoenicians, Málaga has been a capital of many dynasties, as evidenced by two Moorish fortresses still standing today.

LEIXÕES (PORTO), PORTUGAL

The Westman Islands are among Nature's youngest geologic creations. Heimaey's shape and size were drastically changed by a 1973 eruption. Eldheimaris a museum with history of the eruption and an excavated house. The bird cliffs of Heimaey Island are a great place to see puffins, as they nest herein astonishing numbers. 


