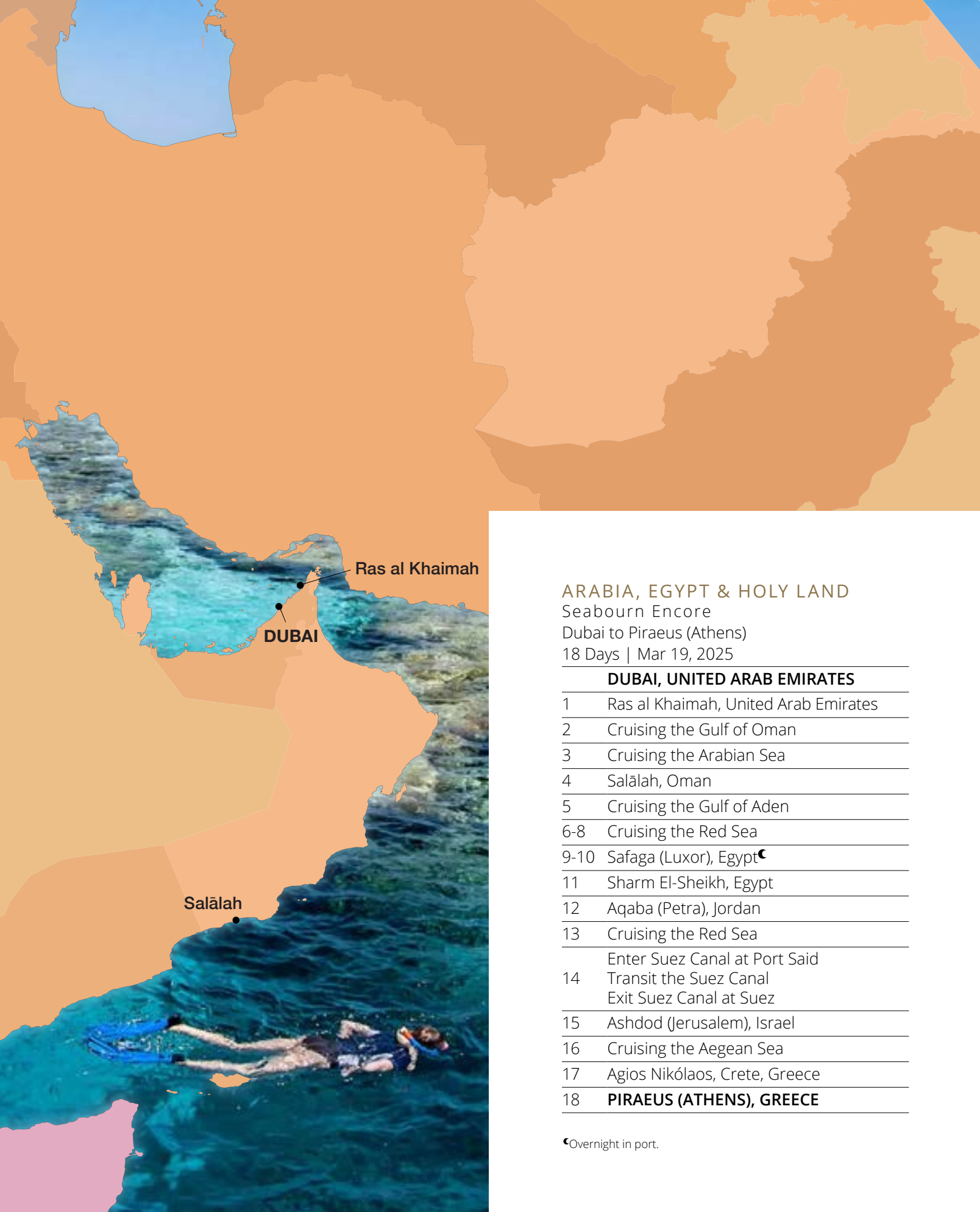

DUBAI, UNITED ARAB EMIRATES

MUMBAI (BOMBAY), INDIA

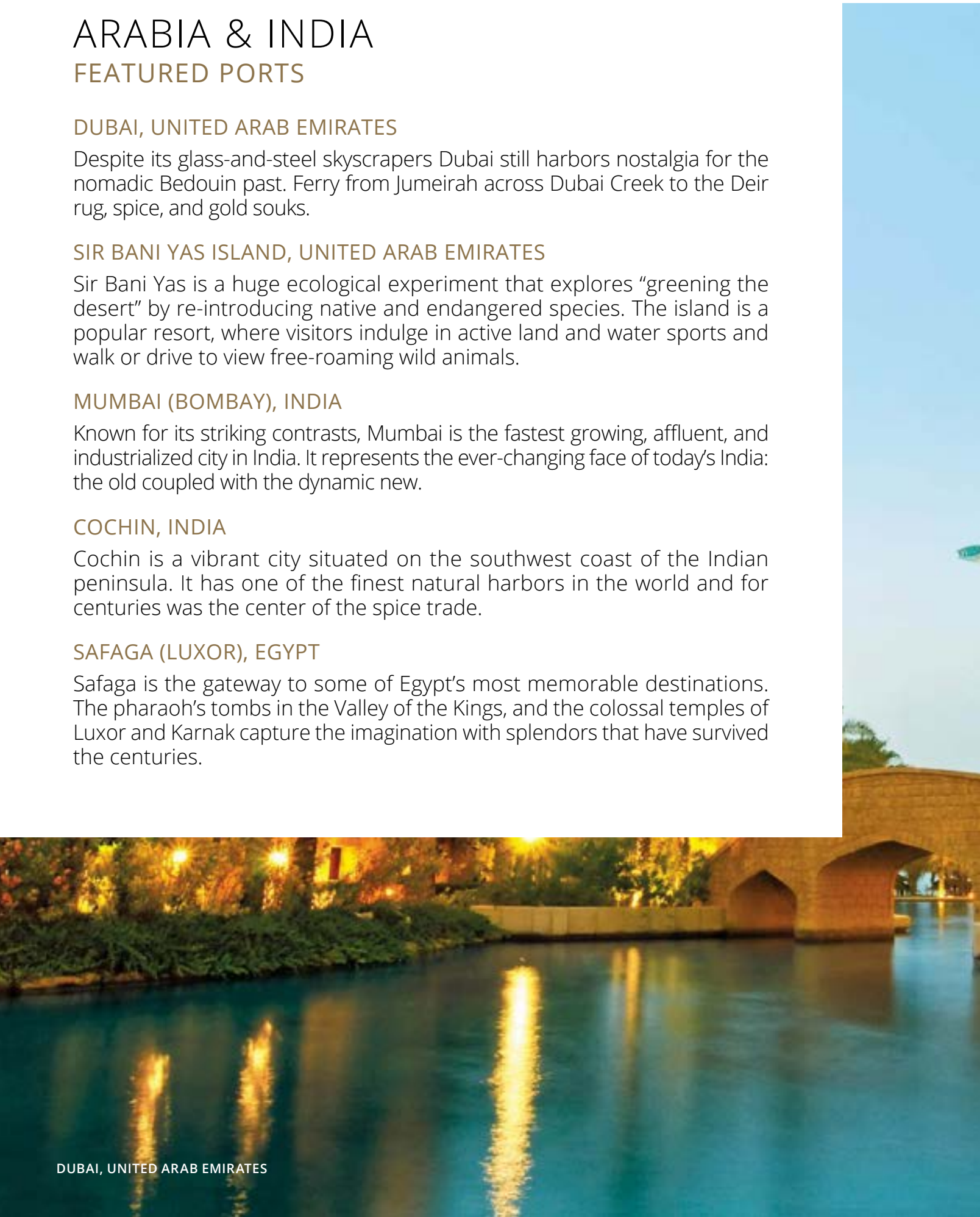

COCHIN, INDIA

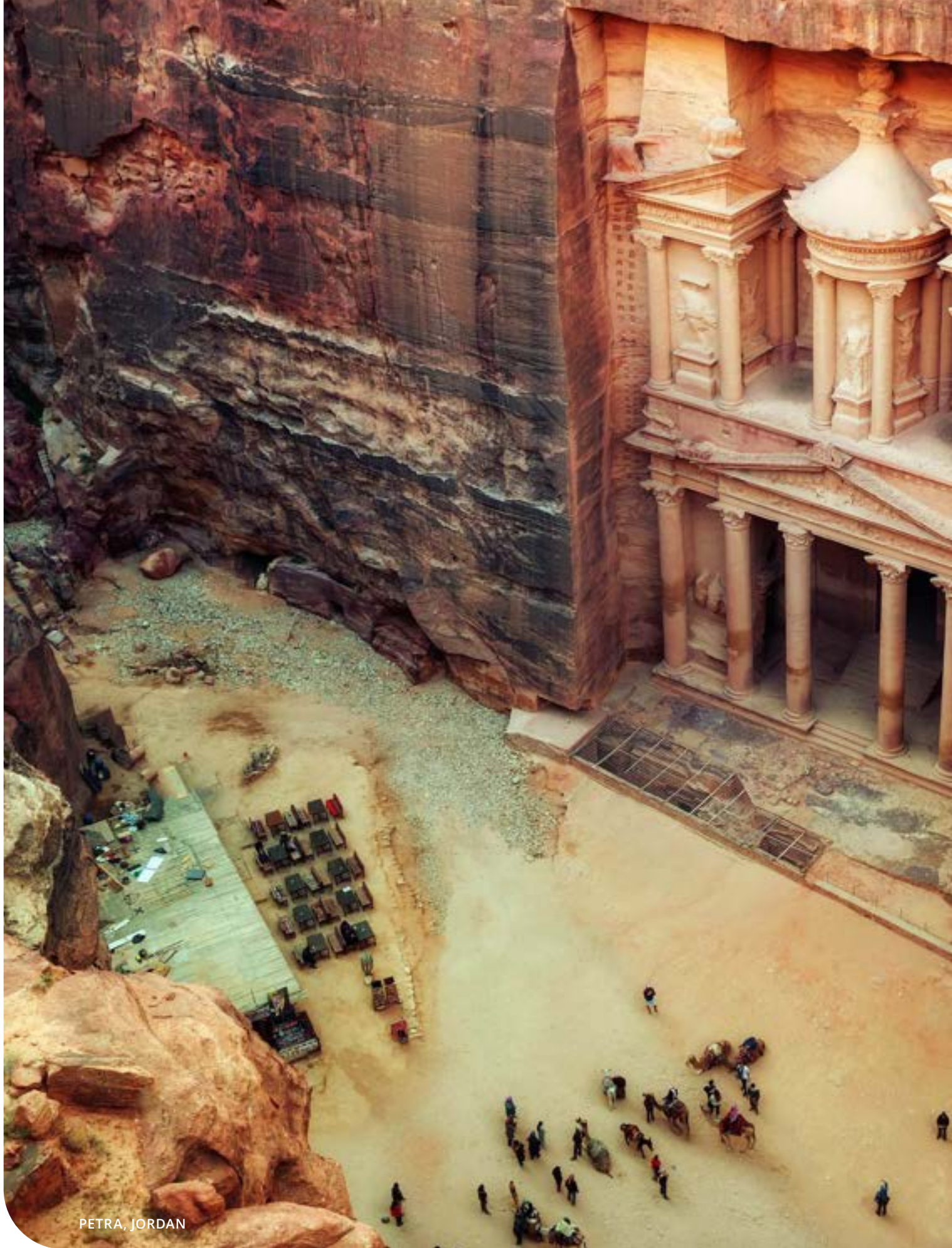

Sri Lanka is a land of jungles inhabited by leopards and elephants, wondrous ruins of the great civilizations of ages past, and a modern city, Colombo, where western technology is superimposed on the passion of a traditional Asian metropolis.

SALĀLAH, OMAN

The tropical atmosphere in Salālah is a striking contrast to the otherwise arid landscapes of the Arabian Peninsula. The beautiful sand beaches, cultural history, archaeology, and natural diversity draw visitors to this ancient paradise.

SINGAPORE

With ultra-modern skyscrapers and Chinese, Indian and Malay influences, Singapore is rich in contrast and color, with a lovely blend of culture, cuisine, arts and architecture.

LAEM CHABANG (BANGKOK), THAILAND

Bangkok is a city of endless fascination. It is an exhilarating mix of chaos and refinement. There is a wealth of history and culture to be discovered here: palaces, temples, markets, and exquisite classical Thai dance performances.

SIHANOUKVILLE, CAMBODIA

Sihanoukville, is located in southern Cambodia on the Gulf of Thailand, and is Cambodia's only international marine port. Its beaches are the most prominent natural feature of the city, spanning most of the surrounding coastline.

HO CHI MINH CITY, VIETNAM

Ho Chi Minh City covers an area of more than 800 square miles. Its land is overwhelmingly rural, dotted with villages and clusters of houses set amidst rice paddies.

DA NANG (HUE), VIETNAM

Da Nang, known as Tourane by the French, succeeded Hoi An as the most important port in central Vietnam during the 19th century. Among the Da Nang area sites of interest to visitors are the Marble Mountains, China Beach, the ancient port town of Hoi An, and the imperial city of Hue.

HALONG BAY, VIETNAM

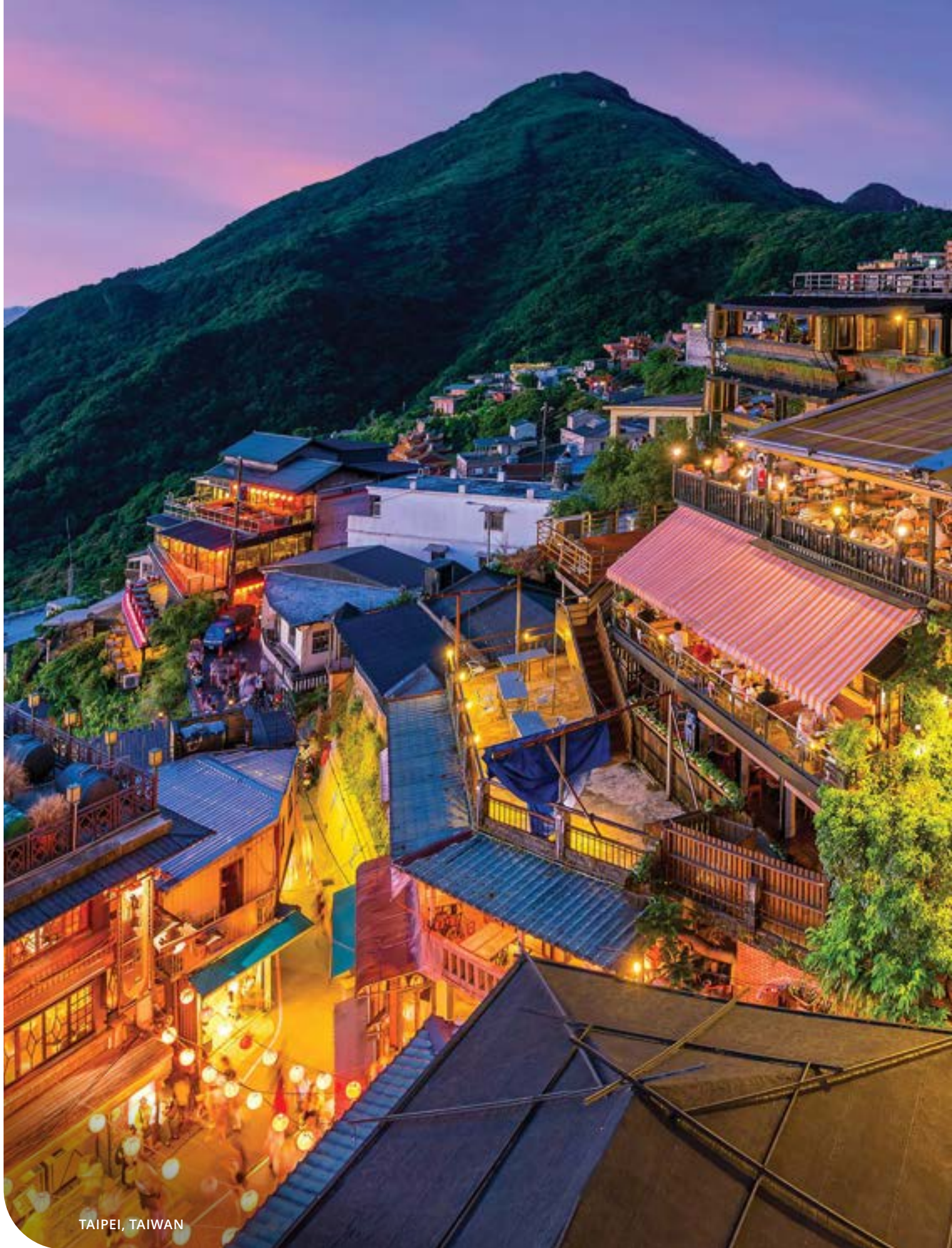
Scattered among picturesque karstic islands, communities of fishing families live on sampans, periodically going into towns such as Haiphong to sell their catch and buy supplies.

HONG KONG, CHINA

One of the most exotic and exciting cities in the world, Hong Kong is loved by both tourists and its citizens for its scenic beauty, fabulous shopping, and memorable dining.







TAIPEI, TAIWAN



PORT KLANG (KUALA LUMPUR), MALAYSIA

Discover Kuala Lumpur's diverse architecture in giant skyscrapers, Malay mosques, Hindu temples, and impressive municipal buildings; marvel at the colorful displays of Hindu deities in the limestone Batu Caves; and visit the 222-acre Lake Gardens with its Orchid Garden, Butterfly Park, and Bird Park.

TAIPEI (KEELUNG), TAIWAN

Taipei's unique blend of cultural grace and modernity for an unforgettable experience. Ascend Taipei 101, explore vibrant night markets and ancient temples, discover opulence at the National Palace Museum and Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall, or experience Yangmingshan's beauty and Beitou's hot springs.

ISHIGAKI, JAPAN

Closer to Taiwan than to Japan's main islands, Ishigaki, as part of the Okinawa Prefecture, is ringed by beaches that vary from sandy expanses to whole strands made up entirely of broken, bleached, and tumbled coral. Lighthouse-marked capes provide stunning views, while most beaches cater to swimmers, snorkelers, and windsurfers.

NAHA, OKINAWA, JAPAN

Deeply marked by WWII, Okinawa now invites travelers to explore its reborn splendor. Marvel at the reconstructed Shuri Castle and serene Shikina-en Garden, walk the ancient Shrikinjocho Stone-Path Road and delve into local history at the Prefecture Museum. In Naha's Tsuboya, discover distinctive Okinawan ceramics.

KOBE, JAPAN

Kobe's ultra-modern Harborland, crowned by the Kobe Port Tower, offers a warm welcome. One of the first cities in Japan opened to trade, Kobe includes a venerable Chinatown and a section of 19th-century Western-style buildings in the Kitano neighborhood.

SHIMIZU, JAPAN

Shimizu, a bustling port on Suruga Bay, captivates with sweeping views of Mt. Fuji, particularly from the UNESCO-listed pine groves of Miho no Matsubara and lofty Nihondaira Plateau. Discover a 650-year-old tree steeped in folklore and visit S Pulse Dream Plaza's sushi museum near the port.

YOKOHAMA (TOKYO), JAPAN

Tokyo, Japan's capital and the most populous city on earth, offers more than enough variety to occupy a lifetime. Some highlights include the Imperial Palace and Gardens, the historic Asakusa district and Sensoji Temple, the National Museum, architectural oddities such as the Skytree Tower and the Tokyo Dome entertainment complex, or the shopping and entertainment meccas of Ginza, Roppongi.

HIROSHIMA, JAPAN

The city was established in the 16th century and although it was an important city throughout the imperial period, its reputation was burned into history when it became the first civilian target of an atomic bombing. Relics of its past such as the impressive Hiroshima Castle were rebuilt, and the city undertook the construction of a Memorial Peace Park, which today attracts visitors from around the world.

HAKODATE, JAPAN

Hakodate, Hokkaido's pioneer in Euro-American trade, showcases Western architecture in Motomachi and Japan's treasured soundscape at Haristo Greek Orthodox Church. It's renowned for hot springs like sea-viewing Yunokawa, housing snow monkeys. Highlights include the 150-year-old star fortress, Goryokaku, featuring traditional Japanese architecture and panoramic views from its tower.

KUSHIRO, JAPAN

Kushiro, cradled by mountains and warmed by ocean currents, boasts plentiful sunshine and an ice-free port. Venture to scenic Lake Akan's hot springs, explore Ainu culture at the museum, admire graceful cranes at the reserve, and traverse Japan's largest wetland via the Kushiro City Marsh Observatory.

NAGASAKI, JAPAN

Once a quaint harbor, Nagasaki on Kyushu Island was transformed by Portuguese explorers in 1543 into a vibrant trade and industrial hub, brimming with Christian and Chinese culture. Despite the wartime tragedy, Nagasaki, phoenix-like, now thrives, its poignant history inviting travelers into its enduring narrative.

DUTCH HARBOR, UNALASKA, ALASKA

Dutch Harbor, nestled on Amaknak Island in the Aleutian chain, is a historic, ice-free Bering Sea fishing industry haven. Brimming with WWII history, it is one of the few U.S. locations attacked during the conflict. Today, it facilitates vibrant intercontinental cargo and passenger travel.

KODIAK, KODIAK ISLAND, ALASKA

Kodiak, Alaska's largest Aleutian Island, marries rich military history with bountiful nature. Explore Fort Abercrombie State Historic Park, visit the Coast Guard's largest base, or witness the impressive fishing fleet. Witness massive brown bears and birdlife, and tour the Baranov Museum - Alaska's oldest standing building.

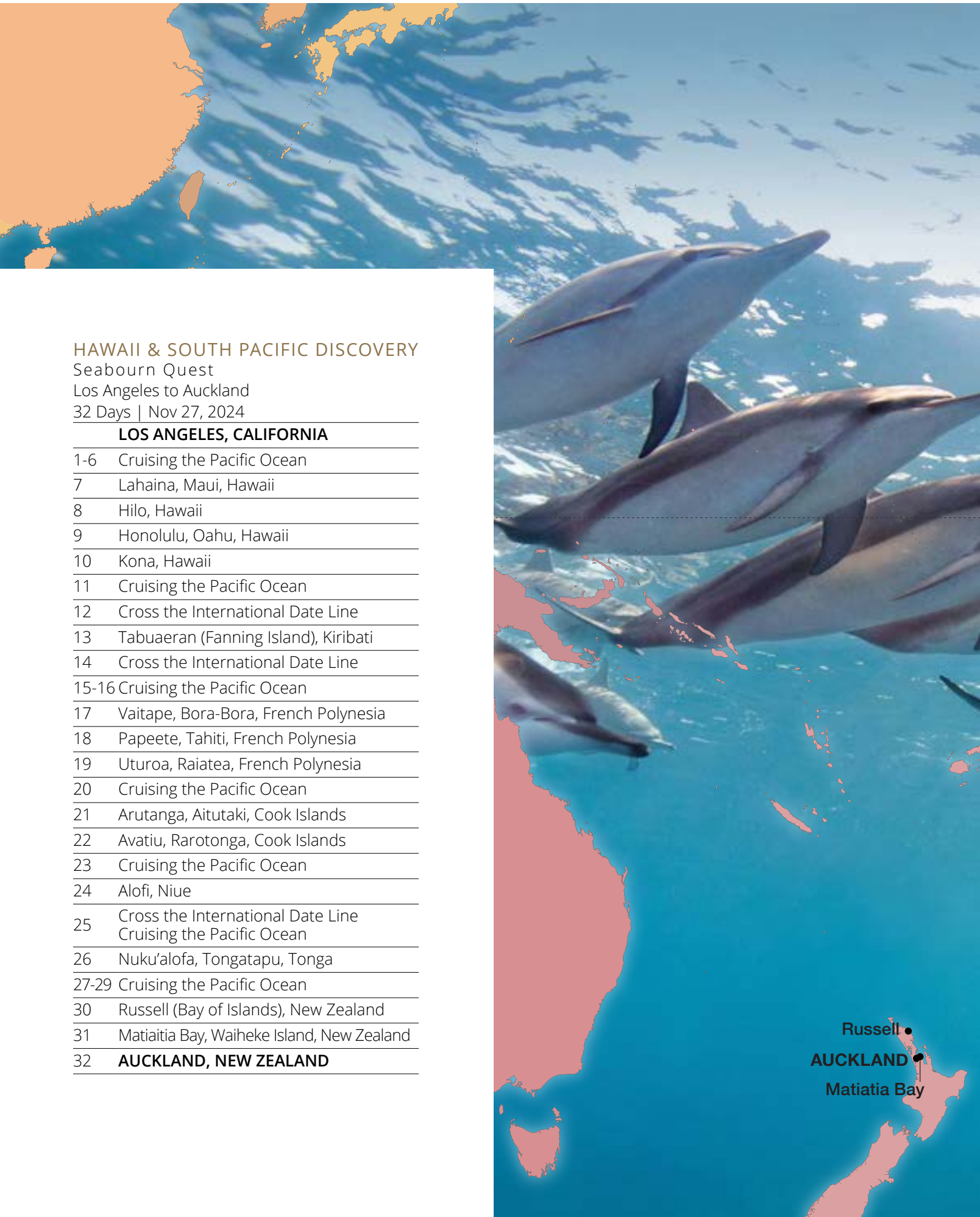

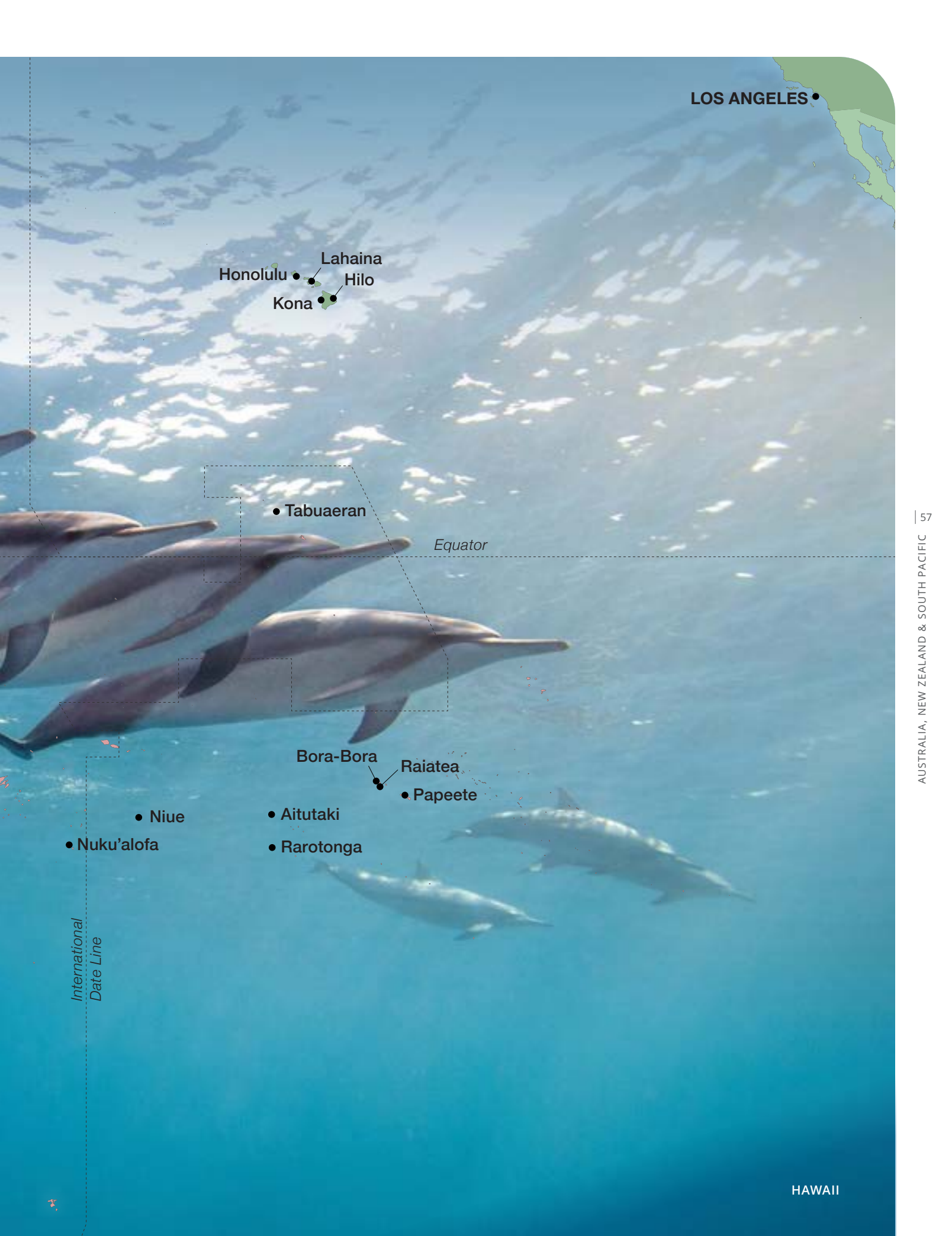

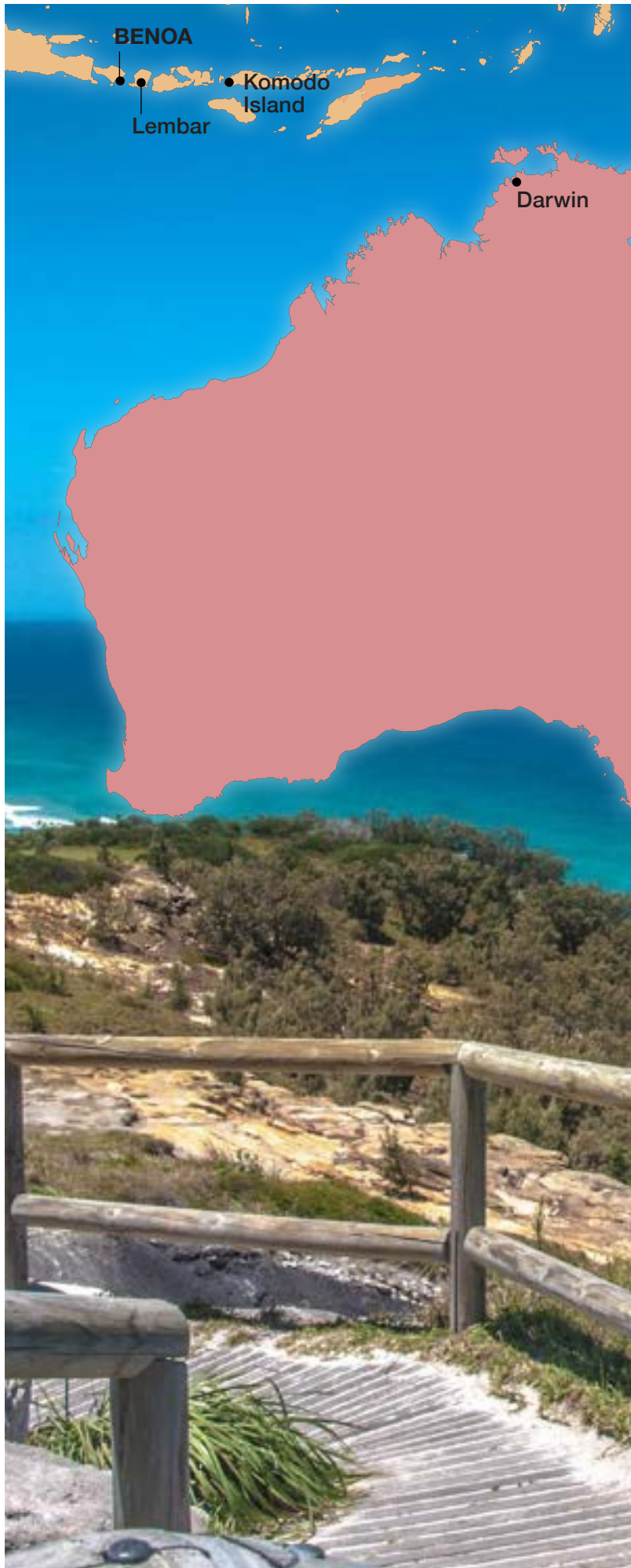

HONOLULU, OAHU, HAWAII

Honolulu's glittering skyline stretches over iconic Waikiki Beach, bustling with energy, shops, restaurants and modern fun. Just outside downtown, Diamondhead, palaces and gardens, and Pearl Harbor pay tribute to the past.

VAITAPE, BORA-BORA, FRENCH POLYNESIA

While its crystalline waters and powder-soft beaches are sights to behold, Vaitape has other surprises like the Marae Fare-Opu temple ruins and the massive WWII Coastal Defence Guns that are worth the short hike.

PAPEETE, TAHITI, FRENCH POLYNESIA

Between wading the shallow lagoon with your snorkel and dive mask, and meandering the lush hillside nature trails, be sure not to miss Papeete's lively gathering of food trucks in the city's main square.

ALOFI, NIUE

Though small, Alofi is filled with a wide variety of outdoor activities. Spelunking limestone caves, whale watching, fishing, swimming, sunbathing and snorkeling are ever-popular pursuits, as is a round of island golf.

KAIKOURA, NEW ZEALAND

Kaikoura draws visitors from all over the world for the prolific marine life in the surrounding waters. Whale (including sperm whales), dolphin and seal watching tours operate year-round.

PORT CHALMERS (DUNEDIN), NEW ZEALAND

Founded in 1848, Port Chalmers is the main port for the city of Dunedin. Today, numerous distinctive and historic buildings remain from the time of its predominantly Scottish settlers, preserving its architectural heritage.





BORA-BORA, FRENCH POLYNESIA

TAURANGA (ROTORUA), NEW ZEALAND

Tauranga is the gateway to the Rotorua Thermal Area, a picturesque region of towering geysers, bubbling mud pots, steam vents and other volcanic phenomena.

MILFORD SOUND, NEW ZEALAND

New Zealand's most famous tourist destination, Milford Sound is a part of the Fiordland National Park and the Te Wahipounamu UNESCO World Heritage Site on the South Island.

MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA

Melbourne boomed in the Victorian gold rush, and by 1865 was the second-largest city in the British Empire. Today, Melbourne is ranked as one of the world's most livable cities.

ASIAOBAN (HALFMOON BAY), NEW ZEALAND

Oban hangs beneath the South Island and is just about the last inhabited place before Antarctica. The island itself is only about four percent inhabited, and that is its attraction. It is a pristine piece of primeval New Zealand.

WELLINGTON, NEW ZEALAND

Wellington is nestled between a magnificent harbor and a natural amphitheatre of forest-clad hills. Its compact size, combined with cultural sophistication, makes it New Zealand's most inspiring urban destination.

PHILLIP ISLAND, VICTORIA, AUSTRALIA

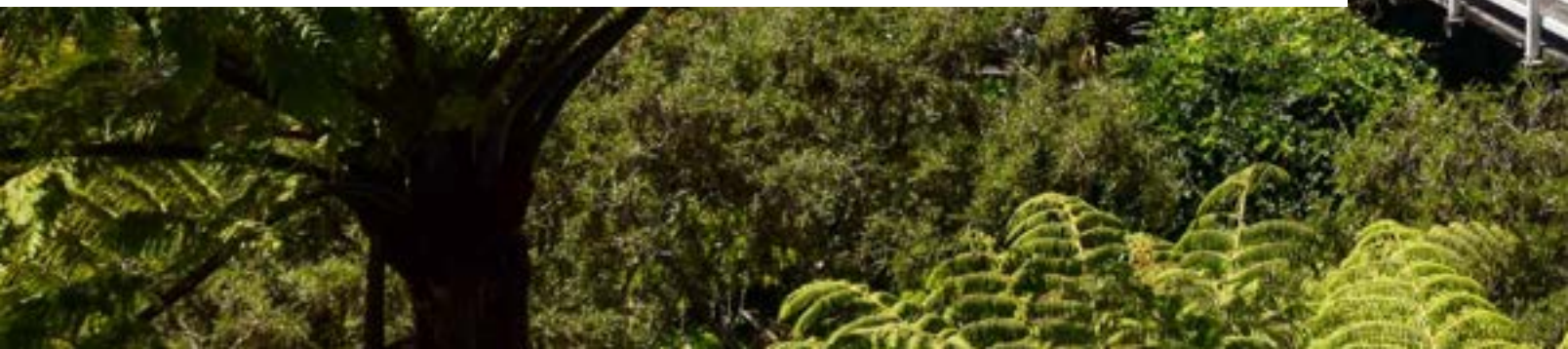
