





Family fun in the wild west



Visit dude ranches that bring out the cowboy in everyone and go into painted canyons, grand and river-carved, on hikes, rafts and horseback rides. Explore the Grand Canyon with a field instructor. Raft down the Colorado River. Flightsee over Lake Powell. Saddle up for a guided trail ride in Bryce Canyon and read the rocks in Zion, millennia old. Reserved stays inside sought-after national park lodges let you enjoy these natural treasures without the day's crowds.

Canada's Rocky Mountain majesty

Discover the wonders of Canada's national parks from wilderness resorts and a castle hotel renowned for scenic settings and outdoor adventures. You'll hike around lakes, glacially made. Raft the whitewater of Athabasca River. Ride an *Ice Explorer* atop a prehistoric glacier. 

Take a guided two-hour walk along the South Rim with an instructor from the Grand Canyon Field Institute; you never know when a mule deer or an elk might make a surprise appearance in this cactus-studded landscape. You'll spend the night near the rim of the canyon in Grand Canyon National Park;



3. The Canyon's east rim & Lake Powell

Spend the morning at leisure exploring the canyon as you please before driving to the East Rim. You'll stop at a variety of lookout points, each providing a different perspective. Then it's on to Page, Arizona, where you'll stay at Lake Powell in Glen Canyon National Recreation Area for the next two nights; your resort on the lake offers many watersport activities. Join us for a private pizza party this evening, weather permitting. **Meals BLD**

Stay inside the National Parks

Experience the national parks as a true insider, sunrise to sunset and after the day crowds depart, with stays at lodges in the heart of the parks.



Zion Lodge Zion National Park, Utah

A member of Historic Hotels of America and the only lodging inside the 146,000 acres of Zion National Park, Zion Lodge boasts the look of a classic rustic inn.



The Lodge at Bryce Canyon Bryce Canyon National Park, Utah

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, The Lodge at Bryce Canyon is the only accommodation that is in the heart of the park.



Kachina Lodge Grand Canyon National Park, Arizona

Steps from the South Rim of the Grand Canyon, Kachina Lodge is also within walking distance of paths that follow the Rim Trail – the views are head-turning wherever you look.

4. Flightseeing & a slot canyon walk

Weather permitting, take off on an included flightseeing* excursion this morning over Lake Powell – you'll get an amazing perspective of the area and one of the largest man-made bodies of water. Today, you also have the option to go on a four-hour flightseeing excursion to Monument Valley, where magnificent sandstone masterpieces tower at heights of up to 1,000 feet; additional charges apply – see details below. This afternoon, head out in a 4x4 vehicle for a guided tour of a mysterious Navajo Nation slot canyon. The remote canyons found here are revered for their special beauty and changing color as the sun moves overhead. Dinner is at leisure at your resort this evening. **Meals BLD**

5. Rafting on the Colorado River


Bring your sunblock and spirit of adventure for a float trip aboard a pontoon raft* down the Colorado River through Glen Canyon; you'll have an opportunity to spot the animals living in this unique sandstone landscape. Enjoy a change of pace and scenery this afternoon when you head north to Bryce Canyon National Park for an overnight stay at the only lodge located right inside the park. Stargazing is excellent here so be sure to look skyward tonight. Meals BLD

6. Saddle up in Bryce Canyon

Wake up to Mother Nature's palette of brilliant colors in the canyon this morning; the weird, whimsical hoodoos and intricately carved pillars of rock may remind you of fairy tale castle turrets - or extraterrestrials. They put on a magnificent "performance" as the rising sun plays over them - so you may want to get up extra early at your inside-the-park lodge and walk a short distance to catch the show! Weather permitting, saddle up for a trail ride* on a horse or a mule with a cowboy who points out hidden geologic sights. Or spend the morning as you wish; Bryce Canyon is home to an ever-changing world of naturally carved amphitheatres, rocky spires, gravity-defying bridges, balancing rocks, and sculpted limestone cliffs. This afternoon, depart for Zion National Park filled with windswept red cliffs, hidden canyons, weeping rocks, and a valley floor carved by a river and furnished with vegetation. Your stay at Zion National Park will be memorable as the canyon landscapes are some of the most scenic in all of North America - and home to 78+ species of mammals. Dine at leisure this evening. Meals BLD

7. Explore Zion National Park

Spend the morning as you wish, "reading" the rocks in Zion's cliff-and-canyon landscape or hiking through narrow pink gorges and dramatic canyons – eight different rock strata, deposited over the course of 200 million years, and

creamy-pink Navajo sandstone cliffs soaring high above you. Early pioneers called this land paradise. This afternoon, you're off to experience something completely different – the jaw-dropping neon-bright world of Las Vegas, which was extravagantly crafted by visionaries and glittering entertainers. You'll stay at the Four Seasons Hotel Las Vegas and have time to enjoy the swimming pool. Join us for a fun-filled farewell dinner at your hotel. Meals BD

Monument Valley Option – \$349

An optional flightseeing adventure* from Page, Arizona, takes you to these tribal lands where countless classic western films have been set for a close-up view of local life with a Navajo guide. En route by plane, you'll get astonishing views of the landscape of sandstone buttes, mesas, and spires that have inspired



generations past – and now inspires your family.

8. Journey home from Las Vegas

Tour ends: Las Vegas. A transfer is included to Harry Reid International Airport from the Four Seasons Hotel Las Vegas. Fly home anytime; checkout time at the hotel is 12:00 PM. Allow two hours for your flight check-in. **Meals B**

1. Arrive Jackson, Wyoming

Tour begins: 5:45 PM, Jackson Lake Lodge. A transfer is included from the Jackson Hole Airport at the base of the Tetons to Jackson Lake Lodge in Grand Teton National Park. Enjoy a welcome reception and dinner. **Meals D**

2. Snake River rafting & Mormon row

On a gentle morning float trip* along the Snake River, your guide shares the area's history and geology and helps you spot river otters, birds of prey, elk – and maybe a moose. Following a chuck wagon lunch, enjoy time to explore the town of Jackson and drive to Grand Teton National Park's Mormon Row Historic District. The evening is free. **Meals BL**

3. American Indian art & geysers

Explore the American Indian artwork and artifacts on display in the park's Colter Bay Visitor Center before traveling to

Yellowstone National Park, where your historic inn is located inside the park near famous Old Faithful geyser. Enjoy some free time for a walk around Geyser Basin and have dinner tonight at your inn. **Meals BD**

Drive to Cody and visit the Buffalo Bill Center of the West. The town was founded by William "Buffalo Bill" Cody, a folk hero who spread his love of the West through Buffalo Bill's Wild West show. Dinner is followed by the Cody Nite Rodeo, featuring bronco riding, bull riding, and team roping. **Meals BD**

6. Bighorn vistas & the cowboy life

Drive through the Bighorn Mountains to the TA Guest Ranch for a visit that includes insights from a horse whisperer as well as a horseback ride* or ride in a wagon. Tonight, your family has an opportunity to enjoy a campfire after dinner at The Ranch at Ucross. **Meals BLD**

7. Crazy Horse & Mount Rushmore

Visit the Crazy Horse Memorial, a 22-story-high Lakota warrior being carved into the side of Thunderhead Mountain.

At Mt. Rushmore, gaze up at the colossal granite heads of four US presidents: Washington, Jefferson, Lincoln, and Theodore Roosevelt. Travel onward to your Black Hills lodge for our farewell dinner. **Meals BLD**

8. Journey Home

Tour ends: Keystone, South Dakota. Fly home anytime; a transfer from the K Bar S Lodge in Keystone to Rapid City Regional Airport is included. Please allow a minimum of two hours for flight check-in at the airport. **Meals B**

This brochure is designed to provide you with an honest description of what to expect on your tour or cruise. The Introduction Pages and the General Information (on this spread) are very important for you to understand. This information, in addition to other documents we will provide when you book with us, including our *Travel Terms and Conditions* and *Journey Confirmation*, form the basis of our agreement with you. These documents include important legal obligations and should be read with care.

Inclusive Prices

2024 prices are per person in US dollars. Prices include: all accommodations (see below); airport transfers and land transportation as detailed in the tour itinerary; basic internet where available in hotel rooms and aboard ships (service levels are not guaranteed); entertainment and special dinners as arranged by Tauck; shore excursions and sightseeing; standard luggage handling (see below). Meals are included as specified. All appropriate gratuities for luggage handling, bellmen, doormen, dining room servers and local guides are included. On-tour airfare is included in the tour cost when flights are part of the trip, as indicated on the tour itinerary. Tauck Director and driver gratuities are included for Tauck Bridges trips.

Hotel & Ship Accommodations: Tauck's per person price is based on double occupancy. Hotel rooms with two beds are usually reserved for doubles. The price for rooms / cabins occupied by one person is higher than those when two or more people share the cost of a room. 
