Our riverboat fleet was custom-designed, purpose-built to enhance your destination experience along the rivers, crafted for smaller ports, and narrow enough to fit through the many locks we navigate along European waterways. Onboard, cabin space is dedicated to actual living space as opposed to increased balcony space, with more than 80% of the cabins featuring French balconies.
