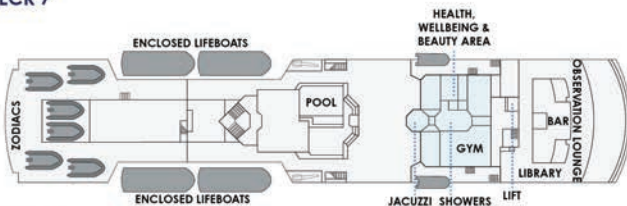
Heritage Adventurer

Birding Down Under

Galapagos of the Southern Ocean

Named after its diversity of wildlife, this voyage explores the spectacular wildlife havens of Australia's Macquarie Island and New Zealand's Subantarctic Islands, home to raucous penguin colonies, sunbathing seals and elephant seals, duelling sea lions, gamming albatross and more.



Beyond Fiordland

In the Wake of Scott & Shackleton

28 Days | From \$49,995 | Jan & Feb 2024/25

Sail south from New Zealand into the heart of Antarctica's Ross Sea, via the Subantarctic Islands, on an epic voyage steeped in history. Expeditions to Antarctica from New Zealand take you further south into the frozen continent than any sea route.

Join our team of expert biologists, geologists and historians on a true bucket list expedition as we Zodiac cruise colossal ice shelves and icebergs, visit research stations, observe whales and seals, walk on the ice with Emperor Penguins and step inside the preserved historic huts of Shackleton and Scott as we follow in the footsteps of Antarctica's legendary explorers.

There are 5 historic huts and many other historic sites that bring this period of Antarctic history alive in a way that the many journals, books and films fail to convey. To visit Borchgrevink's Hut at Cape Adare, Shackleton's Hut at Cape Royds, Mawson's Huts at Cape Denison, Scott's Huts at Cape Evans and Hut Point are once-in-a-lifetime, truly personal experiences.

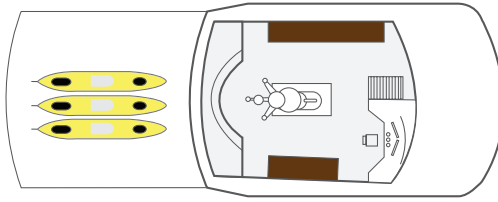

Every year more people will climb Mount Everest than venture into the heart of Antarctica.

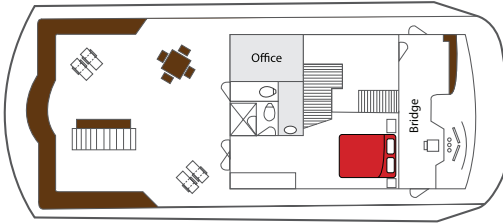
Heritage Explorer

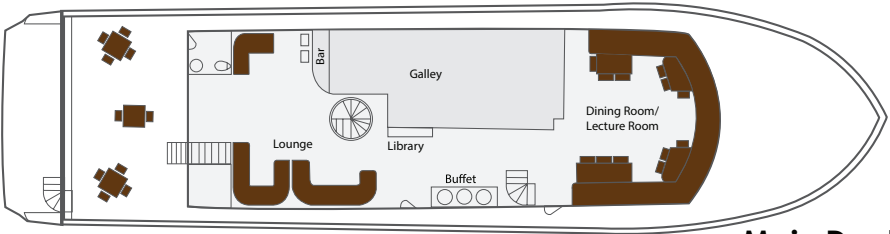




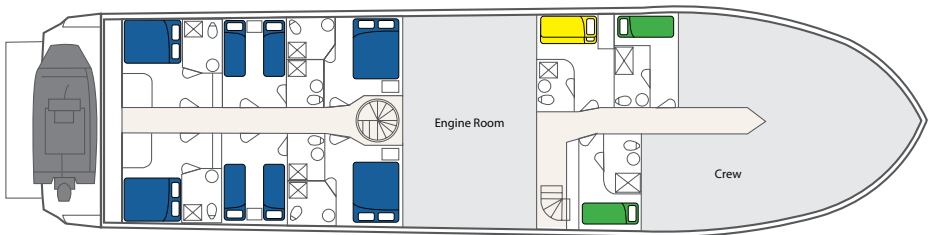
