



She graduated from the University Centre in Svalbard and the University of Oslo with master's degrees in glaciology and geology. Hedda has guided thousands of visitors on Svalbard since 2018 and has worked on expedition cruises since 2020. Born and raised near London, England, Todd currently lives and works in the Canadian Arctic. FREDRIK DOKKA**Bear Monitor**




