Day 3 - 4. **Mesa Verde & Monument Valley.** Saddle up for a trail ride at a local ranch, then continue to your lodge in Mesa Verde National Park, where a private tour of the ancient Cliff Palace speaks volumes about days past. A Navajo presentation and a 4x4 Jeep tour on an overnight stay at a Monument Valley lodge engage with unforgettable natural and cultural discoveries.

Day 5 - 8. **Moab.** Go glamping in safari-style tents during a star-filled three-night stay. Explore Arches National Park; raft the Colorado River; and discover Moab Giants as you make the history of the Wild West come alive with family memories of your own.


Raft down the Colorado River

Warm up to history at Durango Hot Springs

A healing haven of thermal hot springs for centuries, Durango Hot Springs is home to 32 natural hot spring mineral pools, a resort-style swimming pool, cold plunges and more, where you can dip, soak and swim as you like.



Explore Monument Valley by jeep




Explore Yellowstone with park experts
