A LETTER FROM DAN



Dear Fellow Adventurers,

As a boy growing up in Mukilteo, Washington, along the shores of Puget Sound, no school bell could ring loud enough to keep me from exploring our wild coastline. When whales were spotted off the Mukilteo Lighthouse, the entire grade school I attended was allowed to depart the school and walk to the park where we marveled at the whales going by the point. Afternoons and summers were spent combing the tidal flats, inhaling the salt air, and listening to stories spun by boaters and fishermen who had ventured far from the Sound. This early education, so different from my formal schooling, sparked a boundless curiosity about the wonders beyond my hometown.

As I grew older, that curiosity led me north to Alaska. I discovered that if more people could experience these wild places the way I did—up close, in small communities, guided by nature’s rhythms—they’d come to care for them as deeply as I do.

In 1996, this vision took shape with a 12-guest yacht that spent the summer sailing to and from Alaska. We were small, but our ambition was not. Redefining what “cruise” meant became the cornerstone of our identity. It felt natural to our close-knit team, who believed in three things: personal connections, sustainable travel, and genuine immersion in every destination we explored.

Today, as UnCruise Adventures, we’re proud to say our reach extends well beyond Alaska (to Costa Rica, Hawai’i, the Galápagos, and Baja California, Mexico) all while keeping alive that same spark I felt back on Puget Sound.

As we celebrate three decades, my heartfelt thanks goes to everyone who has joined us on the water:

- **Our guests** who trust us with their adventures, returning voyage after voyage and igniting the spirit of travel in others.
- **Our local partners**—the guides, farmers, and community leaders—who welcome us and teach us to tread gently and give back.
- **Our dedicated crews**, from captains and chefs to stewards and guides, who pour their expertise and passion into every trip.

We promise to continue pushing the boundaries of authentic adventure, always putting conservation and community at the heart of what we do, and inviting you into our next chapter—wherever the tides lead.

OUR HISTORY

1997 Started operations with a single 12-guest power yacht on Alaska's Inside Passage.

2001 Launched Gulf of California cruises from La Paz aboard *Safari Spirit*.

2003 Began voyages on the Columbia/Snake Rivers, Washington/British Columbia, and California's Wine Country with *Safari Quest* and *Safari Spirit*.

2008 Captain Dan Blanchard and VP Tim Jacox bought the remaining ASC shares from other partners.

2010 Launched InnerSea Discoveries as an adventurous counterpart to American Safari Cruises and began Hawaii cruises aboard *Safari Explorer*.

2012 Merged American Safari Cruises and InnerSea Discoveries into UnCruise Adventures and expanded Alaska cruises with the new vessels.

2014 *Safari Voyager* began scheduled cruises in Panama and Costa Rica.

2020 During global non-travel, kept guests engaged with inspiring podcasts and daily video content.

2024 *Safari Explorer* began operations in Prince William Sound, Alaska, while *Safari Voyager* expanded Gulf of California cruises to 10-night adventures in the north.

2026 *Safari Voyager* heads back to Costa Rica and *Safari Explorer* debuts new Alaska's Coastal Treasures itinerary.

1996 Founded in Juneau, Alaska, as American Safari Cruises (ASC), pioneering cabin-based, luxurious yacht cruises.

1998 Acquired the 22-guest *Safari Quest* and 12-guest *Safari Spirit*, operating from Juneau and Prince Rupert, Canada.

2002 Purchased the 12-guest yacht *Safari Escape*, initiating cruises in Panama, Costa Rica, British Columbia, and Alaska.

2007 Acquired the 36-guest *Safari Explorer* for Alaska and Hawaii operations.

2009 Acquired the 60-guest *Wilderness Adventurer* and 76-guest *Wilderness Discoverer*, later marketed as InnerSea Discoveries for Alaska and Pacific Northwest itineraries starting in 2010.

2011 Announced voyages to the Galápagos, Amazon River, and Costa Rica, and acquired the 88-guest *Wilderness Legacy*, 74-guest *Wilderness Explorer*, and 84-guest *Safari Endeavour*.


2013 Acquired the 66-guest *Safari Voyager*, soon launching Gulf of California operations.

2017 Completed the longest-ever Alaska cruise season (April to October) aboard *Wilderness Adventurer*.

2021 Led the industry with advanced health and safety measures, operating six months ahead of industry standards and celebrated its 25th anniversary with special promotions as sailing resumed in April post-pandemic.

2025 *Safari Explorer* launches operations in Alaska's Aleutian Islands.

- Lemon Twist




Instructions

- Skiff Tour – A second chance to hop on a skiff and discover hidden coves and coastal wildlife. (~1.5 hours)

NORTHERN PASSAGES *with* GLACIER BAY & SITKA

7 Nights • Juneau to Sitka (or reverse) • Safari Endeavour • Starting at \$5,600 per person

DAY 1 Juneau, Alaska Embarkation Explore Alaska's capital city before boarding. Meet your crew, settle in, and watch for whale spouts from the deck as you set sail.

DAY 2 Captain's Choice The Tongass National Forest is vast and infinitely discoverable. Weather and wildlife guide the day's location. Kayak or paddleboard to get familiar with Southeast Alaska's calm waters and watch for bald eagles, seals, and whales.

DAY 3 Glacier Bay National Park Hot coffee and pastries welcome you to this 3.3-million-acre UNESCO World Heritage site as you marvel at Margerie Glacier or Johns Hopkins Glacier directly off the bow. Take the rare opportunity to get on land and hike the ridge of a glacier or kayak near the deep-blue ice.

DAY 4 Icy Strait Where the Pacific meets northern Southeast Alaska. Spouts and tail slaps are common

as whales patrol these waters. Sea lions surf the swell. Explore by kayak, skiff, or on foot, always searching for wildlife.

DAY 5 Chichagof Island Deep in nutrient-rich waters, Chichagof is home to brown bears, lush meadows, and prolific salmon runs. Spring means wildflowers; summer means salmon; fall might bring Northern Lights. Explore coves or bushwhack.

DAY 6 Baranof Island/Peril Strait Navigate a dramatic coastline of glacial fjords and watch for whales. In Peril Strait, swirling eddies bring marine mammals chasing salmon. Hike or kayak this raw, beautiful setting.

DAY 7 Krestof & Nakwasina Sounds Uninhabited islands, secluded coves, and rugged shorelines. Rocky intertidal zones reveal sea stars and other creatures. No groomed trails—bushwhack through the forest, paddle along the shoreline, or enjoy a snorkel.



DAY 8 Sitka, Alaska Disembarkation Arrive in Sitka, a quaint coastal fishing town. After breakfast, disembark.

WILD, WOOLLY & WOW *with* GLACIER BAY

7 Nights • Roundtrip Juneau • Wilderness Legacy • Starting at \$4,700 per person

DAY 1 Juneau, Alaska Embarkation Explore Juneau by day, then board the *Wilderness Legacy*. The captain and crew welcome you and preview the exciting week ahead.

DAY 2 Hobart Bay Enjoy Hobart Bay deep in the Tongass. Kayak, skiff, or hike among serene waters and evergreen forests. Spot eagles and harbor seals.

DAY 3 LeConte Glacier LeConte is the southernmost tidewater glacier in the Northern Hemisphere. Kayak or skiff among the icebergs. Possibly explore a beach with stranded icebergs.

DAY 4 Thomas Bay, Land of Kushtaka Awaken to the milky-blue waters of Thomas Bay. Hike the Cascade Creek Trail or pick an activity suited to your comfort. Later, reposition for more adventures—kayaking to a salmon run to search for bears.

DAY 5 Whale Watching & Kuiu Island Kuiu Island is black bear country, but the waters also host sea otters, humpbacks, and more. Try snorkeling or kayaking. With nutrient-rich upwellings, you might spot bubble-net feeding, a whale behavior few get to witness.

DAY 6 Brown Bear Search Near the Shores of Chichagof Island Cruise through prime brown bear habitat. Kayak or skiff while keeping your eyes peeled for these majestic creatures. Share stories and photos back on board in the evening.

DAY 7 Glacier Bay National Park Outer Bay Roam parts of the 3.3-million-acre park few get to see. Hike the outwash field of glaciers from the Fairweather Mountain Range. Enjoy a Captain's Dinner and a slideshow of your adventure.

DAY 8 Juneau, Alaska Disembarkation Return to Juneau. After breakfast, disembark, ready to share new tales.

GLACIER BAY ADVENTURE CRUISE

with 2 DAYS in GLACIER BAY

7 Nights • Roundtrip Juneau • Wilderness Discoverer or Wilderness Adventurer • Starting at \$3,800 per person

DAY 1 Juneau, Alaska Embarkation Arrive in Juneau, transfer to your vessel, and set sail for a week of scenic channels and secluded wilderness.

DAY 2 Icy Strait or Neka Bay Kickstart the morning with on-deck stretching or a strong coffee, then snorkel, kayak, or hike. Possibly skiff to a rocky outcropping to watch sea lions. Relax in the hot tub afterward.

DAY 3 Glacier Bay National Park You have two days to explore—more time than most visitors. Hike the outwash field of glaciers from the Fairweather Range, look for bears or wolves, and maybe kayak remote corners of the bay.

DAY 4 Glacier Bay National Park Continued A second day means going deeper into areas rarely seen. Kayak, trek, or observe wildlife from the ship. Naturalists share insights on this dynamic environment.

DAY 5 Chichagof Island Meander through glacier-carved fjords along Chichagof's coast. Drop anchor to lower kayaks and skiffs. Look for bears in the lush forest or explore tidal pools along the beach.

DAY 6 Frederick Sound Humpbacks thrive in these glacial waters. Based on conditions, cruise past Five Fingers Lighthouse and The Brothers Islands. Paddle into Port Houghton or Windham Bay or, for the adventurous, head ashore for a hike.

DAY 7 Tracy Arm & Sawyer Glaciers Gaze at fjord walls reaching skyward, dotted with waterfalls. Harbor seals lounge on ice chunks. Tides permitting, skiff near the glacier face to watch calving. Celebrate the week with a final dinner on board.

DAY 8 Juneau, Alaska Disembarkation Sail into Juneau, enjoy breakfast, and say farewell. Transfer to the airport or continue your travels with a hotel stay or land tour.

ALASKA'S GLACIER WILDERNESS

with GLACIER BAY

7 Nights • Roundtrip Juneau • Safari Quest • Starting at \$8,000 per person

DAY 1 Juneau, Alaska Embarkation Welcome to Juneau! This week, you will explore remote wilderness areas that only the *Safari Quest* can reach. Depart in the evening toward Icy Strait.

DAY 2 Icy Strait Explore remote bays by kayak or skiff, watch sea lions, or join a guided forest hike. Relax on board with views from the hot tub or a drink.

DAY 3 Glacier Bay National Park Outer Bay Discover an area few have explored of this vast park, watching for wildlife including mountain goats, sea lions, puffins, bears, humpbacks, and possibly wolves. Enjoy kayaking adventures.

DAY 4 Admiralty Island National Monument Kayak and skiff through secluded bays, spotting brown bears and bald eagles.

DAY 5 Frederick Sound Watch for humpback whales feeding, view Five Fingers Lighthouse, and learn the unique history. Look out for black oystercatchers.


DAY 6 Windham Bay & Stephens Passage Adventure day! Kayak among marine life, hike through Tongass National Forest, or paddle deeper into wild inlets.

DAY 7 Endicott Arm & Dawes Glacier Explore Endicott Arm by skiff, viewing harbor seals and spectacular Dawes Glacier. Celebrate your journey with a farewell dinner on board.

DAY 8 Juneau, Alaska Disembarkation Enjoy a final breakfast on board before departing for the airport or continuing your Alaskan adventure.

ALASKA'S FJORDS & GLACIERS

with KETCHIKAN

7 Nights • Juneau to Ketchikan (or reverse) • Wilderness Discoverer • Starting at \$3,800 per person

DAY 1 Juneau, Alaska Embarkation Meet your captain and crew as you settle in for a toast. Start scanning for whale spouts right away.

DAY 2 Endicott Arm & Dawes Glacier Navigate between towering granite walls and icebergs in Endicott Arm. Skiff tour close to the face of Dawes Glacier. Watch harbor seals haul out on ice as deep U-shaped valleys tell the story of the last Ice Age.

DAY 3 Frederick Sound Whale Watching Frederick Sound is alive with humpbacks. Misty spouts are sure signs they're nearby. Paddle or hike with your expedition team with each route mapped for your activity level.

DAY 4 Thomas Bay/Wrangell Narrows Explore a playground of glacial mud, muskegs, and waterfalls. Kayak in mirror-like waters, or join an interpretive forest walk. Later, weave through Wrangell Narrows, known as "Christmas Tree Lane."

DAY 5 Blaske Islands An enchanting archipelago shaped by glaciers. A day of choose-your-own-adventure: hiking, kayaking, skiff tours, snorkeling, or "yak-n-whack" combos.

DAY 6 Behm Canal Remote waterways and forested coves. Hike near clear rushing streams or paddle tiny deserted waterways. Keep an eye out for black bears, minks, seals, and eagles.

DAY 7 Misty Fjords Misty Fjords National Monument is a place of overwhelming beauty, with sea-filled glacial valleys and sheer 3,000-foot cliffs. Kayak in Walker Cove or Rudyerd Bay or skiff to a waterfall's base.

DAY 8 Ketchikan, Alaska Disembarkation Arrive in Ketchikan, the "Salmon Capital of the World." After a final breakfast, say goodbye to crew and continue your Alaska journey.

ALASKA'S COASTAL TREASURES

13 Nights • Seward to Juneau • Safari Explorer • Starting at \$8,700 per person

DAY 1 Seward, Alaska Embarkation After your included transfer from Anchorage, board the vessel, attend a safety briefing, enjoy dinner, and set sail, taking mostly overnight crossings to maximize exploration time.

Ships are limited to specific ports (typically larger towns & cities) to meet foreign security requirements. Onboard food and supplies are procured in large port towns outside Alaska, with purchase or support in Alaska.
